PAPER DOVE

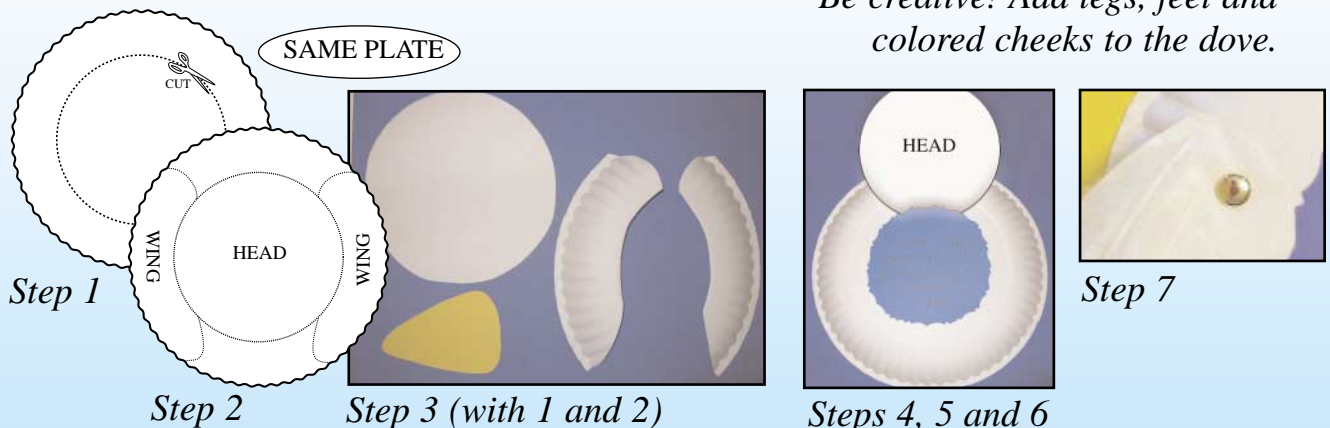
This dove has movable wings and displays an important message.

Items Needed

- White feathers
- White paper plates
- Brads
- Wiggle eyes
- Construction paper – yellow, blue
- Black pen
- Scissors
- Glue



Be creative! Add legs, feet and colored cheeks to the dove.



Directions

1. Cut the middle out of one paper plate.
2. Cut the wings out of the remaining first plate.
3. Cut a beak out of the yellow construction paper.
4. Cut a circle out of the blue construction paper. Write the following verse on it: "This is my son whom I love; with him I am well pleased." –Matthew 3:17
5. Attach the white circle for the head to another paper plate.
6. Glue the blue circle to the middle of the dove.
7. Glue on the beak, eyes and head feathers.
8. Poke brads through the wings and then through the plate.
9. Glue feathers onto the paper wings.

This craft is designed to be made with adult help and supervision. Some of the material can be prepared beforehand for easier assembling by the children.
